

Sweden - a good place to study

The history goes back to some of the universities until XV century. It is in this country has raised the most prestigious academic award - the Nobel Prize. Today, Sweden is a safe and modern country. Universities offer more than 200 programs of study in English starting from the right after the engineering. Sweden is open to foreign students - 7.3% of the total masses of students are foreigners. Studies in this country, in addition to high quality teaching, they also have a great advantage - the fees for education (with minor exceptions) are fully subsidized by the state. This also applies to foreign students who can study for free. Well, almost for free, because you must still take into account the cost of living.

Leaving to study in Sweden, you must decide in which language you want to study. Most students elect a foreign language studies in English. However, if someone knows Swedish and feels up to it, may also choose to program in that language. There is an option - you can go to Sweden in order for there to learn the language. The majority of undergraduate studies is dealt face up in Swedish. However, there are over 200 masters programs, follow-up, where lectures are conducted entirely in English. To confirm our knowledge of English, while the recruitment of an appropriate document to be presented - usually required certificate is a certificate of passing the exam TOEFL (500 - 550 points) or IELTS (score of not less than 5.0). Who is planning to study in Swedish, he should pass the exam TISUS.

Swedish universities put the specific requirements for recruitment. First of all, if we want to apply for admission to undergraduate studies, you must have graduated. To be qualified for complementary studies, you must have a bachelor. Other recruitment requirements will vary depending on the direction of the university and study what we chose. These requirements are based on the Swedish standards for secondary and higher education.

To get to the ideal direction, must be sought from the institutions: the National Admissions Office for Higher Education (the Internet address: www.vhs.se). This organization will send our application to a particular school. Application forms and information brochures (only in Swedish) is available from August to November, when the academic year begins in the spring, and from February to April, if you start studying the autumn. We stress that if applied to study on their own, it is necessary to know Swedish. If you want to take advantage of the Socrates and Erasmus, it must first be a student of English at the university, and then find out if our university student exchange with universities in Sweden.

Most foreign students, studying at undergraduate studies, come to Sweden as part of the exchange student (such as Erasmus or Socrates). Persons who wish to come to study in Sweden on their own, have a somewhat difficult task, since the regulations in this area are severe and the number of places in universities is quite limited.
